**An Act to amend the Public Holidays Ordinance**

[11TH DECEMBER, 1964]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Holidays Ordinance Short title (Amendment) Act, 1964, and shall be read as one with the Public Holidays Ordinance. Cap. 35

2. The Schedule to the Public Holidays Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new Schedule: —

**“THE SCHEDULE**

Schedule to principal Ordinance repealed and replaced

New Year's Day (1st January)  
Zanzibar Revolutionary Day (12th January)  
The two days upon which the festival of Id-el-Fitr is celebrated  
Good Friday  
Easter Monday  
The two days upon which the festival of Id-el-Haj is celebrated  
Union Day (26th April)  
International Workers Day (1st May)  
Saba Saba Day (7th July)  
Maulidi Day  
Tanganyika Independence and Republic Day (9th December)  
Christmas Day  
Boxing Day.”

Passed in the National Assembly on the first day of December, 1964.
