An Act to amend certain laws by substituting for the Term Registrar-General the Term Administrator-General, to confer upon the Administrator-General Powers of Notaries Public and Commissioners for Oaths and to provide for matters connected therewith and incidental thereto

[11TH AUGUST, 1967]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Registrar-General (Transfer of Duties Short title and Powers) Act, 1967.

2. Section 2 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance is hereby amended by adding, immediately below subsection (6), the following:—

“(6A) The expression ‘Administrator-General’, whenever it occurs in any Ordinance, Act or subsidiary legislation shall, unless the context otherwise requires, include an Assistant Administrator-General”.

Section 2 of Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance amended Cap. 1

3. Section 10 of the Notaries Public and Commissioners for Oaths Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by inserting immediately after the word and symbol “Registrar)” in the second line the words “and the Administrator-General”; and
- (b) by inserting immediately after the word “Registrar” in the proviso, the words “or the Administrator-General”.

4. Section 8 of the Adoption Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the word "Deaths" in the definition "Registrar-General" the words "appointed under section 3 of the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance".

5. The Trustees Incorporation Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the expression "Registrar-General" wherever it occurs therein and by substituting therefor the expression "Administrator-General".
