An Act to apply a further sum of thirty-six million seven hundred sixty-two thousand five hundred eighty-nine shillings out of the Consolidated Fund to the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and to appropriate the supply granted

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1972 and shall be read as one with the Appropriation Act, 1971. Short title and interpretation

(2) The expressions used in this Act shall have the meanings respectively ascribed thereto in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance. Cap. 439

2. The Treasury may issue out of the Consolidated Fund and apply towards the supply granted for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1972, the sum of thirty-six million seven hundred sixty-two thousand five hundred eighty-nine. Issue of Shs. 36,762,589 out of the Consolidated Fund

3. The sum granted by section 2 shall be appropriated to the purposes and in the amounts specified in the second and fifth columns of the Schedule to this Act. Appropriation of moneys voted

4.—(1) The Minister may at any time or times not later than the thirtieth day of June, 1972, borrow within or outside Tanzania or partly within and partly outside Tanzania any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole thirty-six million seven hundred sixty-two thousand five hundred eighty-nine by way of loan, advance, the issue of bills Powers of the Minister to borrow

or bank overdraft and on such terms and conditions as the Minister may deem expedient, and may charge any such loan or advance on any of the assets of the United Republic (including securities forming part of the Consolidated Fund).

(2) Any money borrowed under this section shall be placed to the credit of the exchequer account and shall form part of the Consolidated Fund, and be available in any manner in which such Fund is available.

(3) Any money borrowed under this section shall be subject to repayment not later than the thirty-first day of October, 1972 and any sum required for the repayment of any money so borrowed, and of any interest payable thereon shall be charged on and paid out of the Consolidated Fund.
